Town of Scarborough Beach Passes Ferry Beach and Pine Point Beach (Hurd Park)

Resident/taxpayer season pass (either beach)	\$20
Resident/taxpayer combination season pass (includes both beaches)	\$30
Resident—Additional vehicle registered to the same address, per vehicle	\$ 5
Non-resident combination season pass (includes both beaches)	\$60
Resident senior citizen combination pass	
Age 60 and above (both beaches)	FREE
Daily parking fee (without pass)	\$10
Larger vehicle daily parking fee (R.V.'s, campers, buses)	\$35

Dogs on the Beach (Ferry and Hurd Park) Regulations and Owner Responsibilities

June 15 to September 15

- 9:00 am to 5:00 pm - Dogs are prohibited.
- 5:00 pm to Sunrise - Dogs must be on a leash.
- Sunrise to 9:00 am - Dogs may be off leash but must be under voice control; owner or responsible party must have leash in hand.



September 16 to June 14

- Dogs are permitted on beaches but must be under voice control and the owner or responsible party must have a leash in hand

Animal Control Ordinance: Fines range from \$100 to \$500 plus costs for each offense.

Piping Plover Habitats

- No dog shall enter a designated protected habitat area.
- No dog shall approach within 150 feet of an endangered piping plover habitat unless the dog is on a leash that is held by a responsible party.

Piping Plover Ordinance: Fines range from \$50 to \$250.

Piping Plover Federal Endangered Species: Dog owners are liable for pets' actions; fines for taking an endangered species can be up to \$25,000 to \$50,000.
