Dog Information

Municipal Dog Control Ordinance

Dogs within the Town of Scarborough must be under voice control of the owner or responsible party; otherwise, dogs must be on a leash. For all rules regarding dogs, including specific rules for dogs on beaches in Scarborough, please access the town's website:

Dog Licensing

\$6.00 per year for spayed/neutered dogs

\$11.00 per year for dogs not spayed/neutered



To receive a license for your dog, please come into the Town Clerk's Office at Town Hall during our business hours, which are Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday, 8:00 am to 4:00 pm, and Wednesday 8:00 am to 6:30 pm. You may also re-license your dog through the mail or online at https://www10.informe.org/dog_license/. Our mailing address is Town Clerk's Office, P.O. Box 360, Scarborough, ME 04070. You must send a copy of a current State of Maine rabies certificate, along with a check payable to the *Town of Scarborough* for the appropriate fee, and we will process the license and return the material to you.

Per state law, any dog license that is re-licensed after January 31 will be subject to a \$15 late fee; a dog re-licensed on or after April 1 will be subject to a \$25 late fee.

Please feel free to contact the Town Clerk's Office at 730-4020, with any questions you may have.

Note: Although cats do not require a license, they must be vaccinated against rabies.

Dogs on the Beach (Ferry and Hurd Park) Regulations and Owner Responsibilities

June 15 to September 15

- 9:00 am to 5:00 pm - Dogs are prohibited.
- 5:00 pm to Sunrise - Dogs must be on a leash.
- Sunrise to 9:00 am - Dogs may be off leash but must be under voice control; owner or responsible party must have leash in hand.

September 16 to June 14

- Dogs are permitted on beaches but must be under voice control and the owner or responsible party must have a leash in hand.

REMINDER:

Please clean up after your animal.
