



Town of Scarborough Weddings/Special Events Policies

Ferry Beach and Hurd Park (Pine Point Beach) (See policies below for Memorial Park)

- An *OUTDOOR Reservation Form* must be completed and returned to Community Services along with the application fee.
 - Application fee is \$100 and is nonrefundable; this gives permission to hold the wedding (ceremony only) and allows for five free parking spots at Hurd Park or Ferry Beach (passes will be given to applicant for distribution). These five spots are not guaranteed to be open as all parking is on a first-come, first-served basis and reserved spots are not allowed.
 - Parking fee is \$10 per car from 8 am to 3 pm, and \$5 per car from 3 pm to 5 pm. We stop collecting money to park at 5 pm.
 - All wedding participants must access the beach at Hurd Park and Ferry Beach only. There will be no access for any special events (including weddings) from any other public right-of-way.
 - No more than 50 chairs may be placed on the beach for a ceremony. Any extra structures or paraphernalia, such as arches, podiums, tents, are strictly prohibited.
 - The beaches are open to the public; therefore, no portion can be sectioned off at any time.
 - Restroom facilities are available at Hurd Park and Ferry Beach from dawn to dusk between Memorial Day and Labor Day each year.
 - Prohibitions on the beach: Wedding receptions, alcohol, open flame fires, and all vehicles (except for Town of Scarborough maintenance and emergency vehicles). (Staff, please note: During the summer all town vehicles are prohibited from the beach because of piping plovers.)

Memorial Park (Gazebo) (See policies above for Ferry Beach and Hurd Park [Pine Point Beach])

- An *OUTDOOR Reservation Form* must be completed and returned to Community Services along with the application fee.
- Application fee is \$100 and is nonrefundable; this gives permission to hold the wedding (ceremony only).
- Parking is available for approximately 25 people only on a first-come, first-served basis. Additional parking is available at the lower high school parking lot.
- No more than 50 chairs may be placed in the park for a ceremony. Any extra structures or paraphernalia, such as arches, podiums, tents, are strictly prohibited.
- The park remains open to the public; therefore, no portion can be sectioned off at any time.
- Restroom facilities are available from dawn to dusk between Memorial Day and Labor Day each year.
- Prohibitions in the park: Wedding receptions, alcohol, open flame fires, and all vehicles.
